Health Care Partnership:

Philippa reported that she had attended the initial meeting of this new initiative along with 10 other PPG chairpersons from Kent. Woodchurch Surgery update from Dr Jack Hickey:

Dr. Hickey reported that it had been a very busy period but with few significant changes at the Surgery. Hospital delays continue to increase and the Surgery will continue to apply pressure to obtain timely appointments. Drug deliveries are subject to random interruptions, currently liquid based products are in short supply.

QFF: Who is the Community Social Prescriber?

Dr. Hickey replied that there is a team of 8 prescribers working across the 4 surgeries, 5 for adults and 3 for minors. The team assists with non-medical issues. To access their services, you need to go via the receptionists at our Surgery.

QFF: What is the current situation with Covid.

Dr. Hickey responded that Covid is now viewed as another Viral infection and treated as such.

Urgent Medical Help Leaflet

Philippa introduced and circulated the new leaflet that has been generated showing where urgent out of hours medical help is available. She highlighted that this has been put together as a supporting document and in no way replaces official guidance.
